

Printing the Dash-in Dungeons DEMO card-set:

Overview of the cards:

The PDF file contains 10 pages with 9 cards per page (page size: A4).

The first 8 pages contain the **fronts** of the cards in the Dash-in Dungeons demo set. The last 2 pages are the card **backs**. You may choose to print only the card fronts (Pages 1 to 7) which will allow you to play the game, however, it is recommended that you (at least) print card backs on the Battle Sequence and the Fate Cards to distinguish them from the other game components when they are face-down.

To print card backs onto the same pages as card fronts, make sure you maintain the orientation of the top of the page (as you see it on the screen) when printing the card-back. In most cases, this simply means turning the page with the card front printed on it over from long-edge to long-edge, so that the 'top' of the page is in the same place (probably feeding into the printer first) as it was when you printed the card fronts on that page.

You should print the document from Adobe Acrobat Reader **without Print Scaling** so that the size of the cards is as accurate as possible.

It is recommended that you print the Dash-in Dungeons demo on a light card stock (say around 200gsm or higher). The heavier the card, the better the results and the longer your cards will last.

Use scissors (or a guillotine) to cut your cards out of their A4 sheets, and cut-out and assemble the fold-up miniatures (as shown on the 'Fold-up miniatures' instruction card).

As a guide, here is a list of the cards on each page of the PDF file:

Page 1: Adventure (3 cards on the top-row) & Rules reference cards: Player Quick Reference 1 to 3 & Dealer Quick Reference 1 to 3.

Page 2: Dealer Quick Reference cards: 4 to 7, Fold-up miniatures instruction card, Gold treasure cards & Monster statistics card.

Page 3: Character cards: Wizard, Streetman, Dwarf, character Skill reference cards, Injury cards.

Page 4: Fate cards.

Page 5: Fate cards & Fold-up miniatures.

Page 6: Dungeon Tiles & Injury cards.

Page 7: Injury cards.

Page 8: Battle Sequence cards.

Page 9: Card-backs for cards on Pages 1 to 7.

Page 10: Card-backs for cards on Page 8.

Technical information about the document:

The PDF file was created in Microsoft Publisher 2003 and was output as an Adobe Acrobat Composite Greyscale document (via Acrobat Distiller v 7.0 for Windows).

It was generated in RGB colours and then converted to Greyscale. It should be printable on most desktop, inkjet printers. The page size is set to A4 (8.26 x 11.69 inches – portrait orientation).
